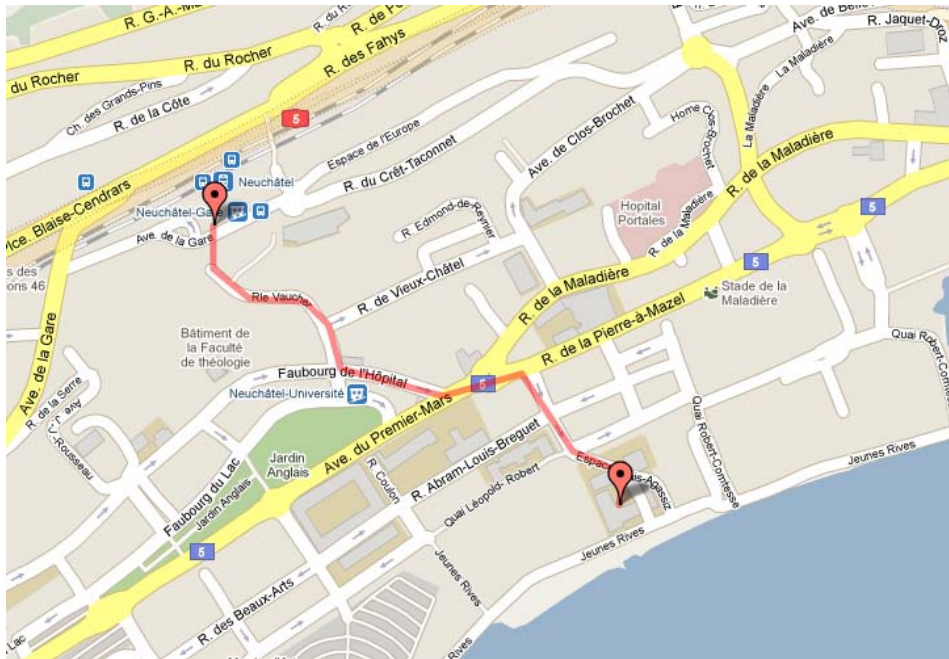

## Location and directions from the station

There are two ways of getting from the station to the conference location:

1. A ten minute walk: Leave the station on the downhill (lake) side and find one of the sets of stairs that heads downwards in the direction of the lake. Keep walking towards the lake and you will eventually see a red church. The Faculté des lettres is between the red church and the lake. (The route marked on the map is one of several possible routes.)

2. The *funambule* (cable car): It leaves from the lower floor of the train station every five minutes. Buy a ticket "court parcours" for 2 CHF at the ticket machines. The first and only stop is at the Jardin Anglais (marked in green in the above map). From there, walk along the Ave. du Premier-Mars until you see the red church. The Faculté des lettres is between the church and the lake.

Our conference room, R.O. 14, is situated on the ground floor of the west wing of the faculté des lettres building, i.e. on your right-hand side if you look in the direction of the lake.
